Agenda: Tying your season's productive patterns

Each season there are some fly patterns that seem to work better than others. For example, I have a spent caddis pattern that seems to work well when the CDC wings are tied a bit longer and backward in a V shape. The fly may be more of a spinner than a spent pattern, but it works nonetheless.

It's likely that many of our members have had similar experiences—finding a fly pattern that worked particularly well this past season—and we can all benefit from a bit of show and tell as you bring your favorite patterns from 2022 to our October meeting.

As far as my spent caddis goes, the fly is quite easy to tie:

Hook: Standard dry in sizes 12-16 Thread: Green (black, red, and yellow also work) Body: Light tan fox fur Wing: Natural dun CDC
