Dark Hendrickson Wet

Hook: Size 14 Mustad 3906B or

other wet-fly hook

Thread: Brown 6/0 or 8/0

Tail: Wood duck flank feather

fibers

Body: Muskrat Hackle: Dun hen

Wing: Wood duck flank





<u>Light Hendrickson Wet</u>

Hook: Size 14 Mustad 3906B or

other wet-fly hook

Thread: Cream 6/0 or 8/0

Tail: Wood duck flank feather

Body: Cream dubbing Hackle: Cream hen

Wing: Wood duck flank



Hendrickson Nymph

Hook: Size 12 or 14 1xl nymph hook

Thread: Brown 6/0

Tail: Well-marked wood duck flank barbs

Abdomen: Reddish-brown fur with a band of grey fur behind the throrax or in

mid section (look at your local nymphs)

Ribbing: Copper wire (fine) Thorax: Reddish-brown fur

Wing case: Black section of turkey tail

Legs: Well-marked wood duck flank or partridge barbs
